

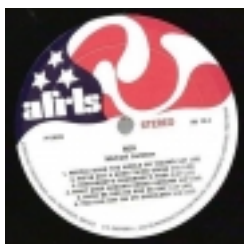

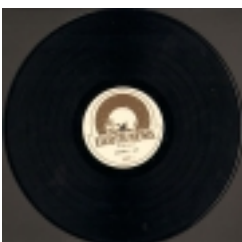
Dick Clark's Rock, Roll, And Remember #207 (USP) Radio Broadcast Album *4LP Set* (USA)

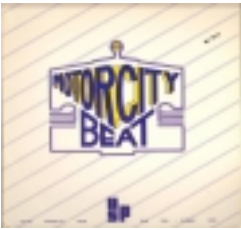
Herman Griffith AFRTS (American Forces Radio And Television Service) Radio Broadcast Album (USA)

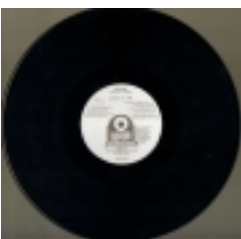
Motor City Beat: December 26, 1987 Radio Broadcast Album *3LP Set* (USA)

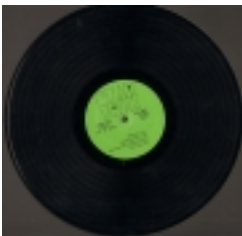
Record Report With Robert W. Morgan: January 15, 1979 Radio Broadcast Album (USA)
