Captain EO Blue Print Of 3D Theater Project (USA)



Captain EO is a <u>3-D film</u> starring <u>Michael Jackson</u> and directed by <u>Francis Ford Coppola</u> (who came up with the name, "Captain EO", (from the Greek, cf. "Eos", the Greek goddess of dawn) that was shown at <u>Disney</u> theme parks from 1986 through the 1990s. The attraction returned to the Disney theme parks in 2010, as a tribute after Jackson's death.

The film's executive producer was <u>George Lucas</u>. The film was <u>choreographed</u> by <u>Jeffrey Hornaday</u> and <u>Michael Jackson</u>, <u>photographed</u> by <u>Peter Anderson</u>, produced by <u>Rusty Lemorande</u>, and written by Lemorande, Lucas and Coppola, from a story idea by the artists of <u>Walt Disney Imagineering</u>. Lemorande also initially designed and created two of the creatures, and was an uncredited editor of the film. The score was written by <u>James Horner</u>, and featured two songs ("We Are Here to Change the World" and "<u>Another</u> <u>Part of Me</u>"), both written and performed by Michael Jackson. The Supreme Leader was played by <u>Anjelica</u> <u>Huston</u>. Cinematographer <u>Vittorio Storaro</u> was the Lighting Director during much of the principal photography. Captain EO is regarded as one of the first <u>"4-D" films</u> (4-D being the name given to a 3-D film which incorporates in-theater effects, such as lasers, smoke, etc., frame synced to the film narrative).^[2] This innovation was suggested by producer-writer Lemorande who is, therefore, sometimes referred to as "The Father of 4-D."
